1)Abortion Information (H0559): Requires that informed consent material be made available to women considering an abortion on a secure website and that abortion practioners and their agents provide the address to women considering an abortion.

Sponsor: Rep. Lynn Luker (R-15). Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed 55-10

2)Political Parties Self-Governance (H0612): Deregulates Political Party internal governance. Sponsor: Rep. Thomas Loertscher (R-31) Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed: 49-16

3)Illegal Immigrant Driver's Licenses (H0366): Bars issuance of driver's license to those who are not in the U.S. Legally. Sponsor: Idaho Department of Transportation. Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed 47-21

4)Grocery Tax Relief (H0588): Sponsor: Rep. Clifford Bayer (R-21): Increase the Grocery Tax credit for all Idaho families. Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed 62-8

5)Abortion Coercion (H0654): Makes it a crime to physically coerce or threaten to physically coerce a woman to have an abortion. Sponsor: Rep. Bob Nonini (R-5) Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed: 55-11
